ALSO TAKE NOTE THAT voter letters, which provide the required information to vote electronically, will be sent out via Canada post mail based on the names and addresses provided by the List of Electors(Preliminary List with changes), so please contact the above if you have any concern about your information on the list. Please do not automatically assume you are on the list or that the information is correct.

VOTER QUALIFICATIONS

Individuals are qualified to vote in the municipal election if they are:

1. The full age of 18 (born on or before October 5, 2020) on the 1st advance polling day (October 5, 2020);
2. Is a Canadian citizen on the 1st advance polling day (October 5, 2020); and
3. Must be ordinarily resident in the province of Nova Scotia for a period of six (6) months immediately preceding the 1st advance polling day (April 6, 2020); and
4. Is ordinarily resident in the Municipality of Shelburne immediately before the 1st advance polling day (October 5, 2020).

Additional qualifications to allow an individual to vote for the CSAP School Board member are:

1. The individual is a Canadian citizen; **and**
2. a) Whose first language learned and still understood is French; **or**
b) Who received their primary school instruction in Canada in a French-First-Language program; **or**
c) Of whom any child has received or is receiving primary or secondary school instruction in Canada in a French-First-Language program.
