ARTFUL ANTICS

DAY 1

Leaf Etching

Supplies

- Leaves
- Paper
- Crayons or Colored Pencils

Instructions

- Grab sticks, leaves and flowers that you find on the ground and find interesting
- Put your favourite leaves on a flat surface and put a white piece of paper on top
- Now shade over top of your leaves with different colours to make a rainbow

Nature Paintbrush

Supplies

- Sticks
- Flowers
- String
- Paint

Instructions

- With the rest of your items go somewhere you can make a mess because you most likely will
- Tie your best looking flowers and leaves to their own stick (**save extra string**), now dip them into paint and add cool designs to your rainbow leaves or on a new piece of paper

Rock Tic Tac Toe

Supplies

- Rocks
- Paintbrush
- Paint
- Paper

Instructions

- Collect about 10 small rocks
- Paint 5 rocks one colour and the other 5 another, using cool designs if you wish
- Now on a piece of paper draw a tic tac toe board, or use sticks outside to make one
- You and a partner will each have your own colour, take turns placing the rocks in the squares in order to get three of the same colour in a row

ARTFUL ANTICS DAY 2


Pressed Flower Bookmark

Supplies

Contact paper or laminator	Various leaves and flowers
Yarn, string, or raffia ribbon	Cardstock
Scissors	Glue

Instructions

- You'll need some pressed leaves and flowers.
 - Take a nature walk and pick some small flowers and leaves.
 - Placing them inside the pages of a thick book for 3-4 days.
 - Once your flowers and leaves are pressed and dry, carefully remove them from the book.
- Use your pressed flowers and leaves to make a design on your cardstock. Once you're happy with the design, you'll want to lightly attach the flowers and leaves to your bookmark with glue before you permanently cover them up.
- Next you'll want to cover the bookmarks with plastic to protect them during use, this is done using contact paper, or with a laminator if you have one
- Trim off excess contact paper
- Cut a hole in the top for your string
- Tie a string at the top
- Enjoy with your favourite book

ARTFUL ANTICS DAY 2


Sock Rabbit

Supplies

Sock(s) Scissors
Rice Ribbon
Twine

Instructions

- Fill the toe and foot of the sock with rice up to the beginning of the heel. Fill the sock with enough rice so that it can stand up on its own, and makes a nice, fat bunny, making sure all of the rice falls to the foot of the sock. I suggest just poking a hole in the bag of rice and carefully pouring.
- Pinch off the rice ball in the upper-middle, forming the head and body of the rabbit.
- Using twine, tie off the top heel of the sock directly above the rice, forming the bunny's ears. Tie the sock off again where you have pinched it to form the head and body (**save all extra string for day 3**).
- Starting at the open top and ending at the first ear-making tie-off, cut the heel in half to form the bunny's two ears. Continue to carefully cut, snip and trim away the extra fabric to form two even, oval bunny ears.
- Tie the ribbon in a bow around the second twine tie-off, at the bunny's "neck" between the head and body.
- Use the marker to draw a face on the bunny's head. All you need to do is make two little dots for the eyes, and a little "X" for the mouth

DAY 3

Structure Design

Supplies

- Popsicle Sticks
- Glue

Instructions

- Take all your items and go somewhere flat with lots of room
- Now all you have to do is imagine what you would like to build and then build it, simple as that, I know!
- If you want to make a house, put four sticks together as the base and glue them, now add more to make it taller then add a roof, if you need smaller sticks ask an adult to break them. Try to build a tower as tall as you can
- Or make your favourite animal, although I don't know what your favourite animal is so I can't really help you there, but good luck anyway!
- P.S. if you need more sticks bring me a popsicle and I will give you another stick because I am nice

String Balls

Supplies

- Balloons
- Thread
- Glue
- Patience

Instructions

- In a large bowl, mix the glue with a small amount of water to thin out the glue
- Inflate the balloon
- Place the string in the bowl to cover all the string in glue
- Wrap the strings around the balloon (P.S. this is going to get messy, so prepare yourselves adults)
- Let string dry
- Pop the balloon and remove from the inside of the egg carefully
- Enjoy your egg

Creative Writing

Supplies

- Paper
- Pen
- Imagination

Instructions

- Go somewhere you can focus on writing, are comfortable, and relaxed
- Write a story, poem, or play
- If you are having trouble starting try one of these prompts
 - If you could be any animal, what would you choose? Describe your day as that animal.
 - Write as if you are a bird flying over a beach
 - Write about the best camp out EVER
 - What does a typical day look like for a mermaid?
 - Write a story using these three words
 - 1) Tree
 - 2) Toadstool
 - 3) Ant

Nature Walk

Supplies

- Yourself
- Comfortable Clothing

Instructions

- When you go out in nature you can realize the art in nature.
- Go for a walk outside and try to imagine everything as a painting or drawing.
- Ensure when you are on a nature walk you are respecting nature, leaving this as you found it
- Remember leave only footprints, take only memories
 - If you bring garbage with you bring it out of nature
 - Don't take anything out of the environment it was in, it is important for all creatures

Instructions

Fairies are the protectors of nature. They usually come out at night and ensure that the environment around them is respected by the day dwellers (humans). They mostly live high up in the treetops, but usually love to make homes at the base of the trees in the summer when there is no snow or ice.

Typically the Summer Recreation staff would ensure they visited the fairies and built them houses at the base of the trees for the summer. But the summer recreation staff are so busy making fun packs and planning safe summer fun so they have less time to build houses for the fairies than they did last year, so we need your help! The fairies would love it if you could help build little houses for them using things from nature. Remember, fairies are shy, so you may not see them but they do enjoy the homes you leave them after they've gone.

Frequently Asked Questions About Fairies

Q1: Can fairies see and hear us in the day?

A1: Yes! But are very shy and try to stay away.

Q2: How can we tell if the fairies use our home?

A2: The fairies are VERY shy and tidy. You may not be able to tell by looking at it if the fairies used it at all, but they will let the Summer Recreation Staff know.

Q3: Can we communicate with the fairies?

A3: Fairies have their own secret fey language, the Summer Recreation Staff are taught it in training. Few others know their language.

Supplies

Banana
Smarties
Graham Crackers
Chocolate Chips

Instructions

- First off I would like to apologize to all of you who do not like bananas, I do not either, if you do not want to use a banana for this snack then you can use something else that is healthy, like a hot dog, I guess? I don't know, use your imagination.
- For all of you who like bananas peel your banana so it is out of the peeling and place it on a plate or napkin

This activity will be led by our Summer Recreation Staff. We ask that parents remain with their youth during this activity and ensure they are staying 2 metres away from other families during the event.



Supplies

- Jar
- Nature items

Instructions

- Go out into the forest, beach or anywhere that will have nature items lying around
- Collect your favourite items that you find on the ground and put them in your jar
- When you have filled your jar or have put all the items you wanted to in it, put the cover on it and display it somewhere in or outside your house where it will not break



Box Guitar

Supplies

- Cardboard box (tissue or cereal)
- Paper towel roll
- Rubber bands
- Tape

Instructions

- If you have a tissue box skip this step.
 - Take your box and cut a hole in the middle, about the size of a tennis ball
- Tape the paper towel roll lengthwise to your box and line it up with the hole
- Decorate it as you see fit
- Take your rubber bands and cut one end to make them a straight line.
- Poke a small hole at the end of the roll and tie the bands, add tape if needed.
- Stretch the bands over the hole to the other side of the box, tape and tie the bands to the bottom
